1. The City of Old Town Public Works department (seller), is seeking sealed bids for surplus vehicles and equipment listed on the attached Bid Form.

The bid envelope must be clearly identified with “Surplus Equipment Bid 10-01”.

The deadline for receipt of bids is 2:00 PM, October 20, 2020. Bids received after this time will not be considered.

3. Inspection: Vehicles and Equipment may be inspected at the Public Works Department, 73 Airport rd Old Town 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM Monday through Friday. All bidders are encouraged to inspect vehicles and equipment before submitting bids.
4. Condition of Vehicles: Equipment is offered for sale “Where is” and “As is” without any warranties, express or implied, as to merchantability or fitness for purpose.
5. Tie Bids: Bid responses will be time and date stamped upon receipt at the Public Works Department. If identical bids are submitted, the bid will be awarded to the first offer received. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
6. Buyer agrees that Seller shall have no liability for consequential, incidental, special, or punitive damages arising out of this agreement.
7. Buyer shall be responsible for all packing, insurance, and transportation costs associated with the removal of the item (s) purchased and identified herein.
8. **Buyer must remove all the purchased item (s) from the City premises within 7 business days after notice of award.** Buyer shall not salvage desired parts from the item (s) and leave the unwanted parts behind. Buyer shall remove all unused materials associated with the item (s) purchased and leave the premises in a neat and clean condition at the completion of the work.
9. Buyer assumes full responsibility for, and title to, item (s) upon payment and Buyer signature on the bill of sale. Upon transfer of title, all risk of loss shall transfer to Buyer, and Seller shall have no liability of any sort for any damages of any kind which may result from Seller’s removal, transportation, shipping, use, disposition, or disposal

in any manner for the item (s) purchased herein.

10. Buyer will be responsible to make full restitution for any damages caused to City property during removal of item(s) from City premises.
11. Buyer shall indemnify and hold the Seller harmless from and against any injury, loss, damage, claim or liability therefore arising from any omission, default or neglect of the Buyer, the Buyer's agents or employees in connection with the removal of the item(s).
12. Seller will provide Buyer with reasonable access to the item(s) to allow for the removal during normal business hours by arrangement with the contact person listed herein.
13. Payment must be made by bank check payable to the City of Old Town or cash.
